NICKS KIDS

Nickerson Gardens projects located in South Los Angeles, is a dangerous neighborhood often filled with gangs, violence, and drug related activities.

Many of the children living inside Nickerson Gardens are afraid and cannot play outside due to the danger of violence.

Nicks Kids was started in late 2016 by LAPD Senior Lead Officer Joyce and community member Lupita Valdovino, a teacher for LAUSD. The goal was to ensure every child should experience childhood through the lens of positivity; surround oneself with positive role models and a positive environment to ensure a positive future.

Our program is implemented in two parts. The soccer program teaches the kids that an active lifestyle rooted in self-respect and respect for others are the foundation for a positive life. Together they learn the importance of team work and to face challenges head-on, with positivity and unity.

The second part of our program is teaching the importance of education. Private tutoring is offered at no charge twice a week and each child's grades are monitored closely by staff. If a child's gpa drops under 2.8 they can no longer play in games until their gpa improves. The past five years we have seen our programs academic success grow each year.

NICKS KIDS FACTS

- First year of recording grades the program had a 2.95 cumulative gpa, improving each year. This past year finishing with a 3.4 cumulative gpa.
- 86% of our student athletes maintain a minimum 3.0 gpa.
- The program has had 8 high school graduates, all attending college.
- 2021 high school graduates had a total of 32 college acceptances, including Notre Dame, UCLA, USC, and several others.
- 2022 high school graduates had a total of 16 college acceptances, including Gonzaga and Baylor amongst others.
- Team captain Gabriel Banuelos awarded the 2021 Billie Jean King Youth Leadership Award presented in New York at the ESPN awards in July of 2021.
- 12 kids on scholarship to private schools because of donors.

NICKS KIDS REQUIREMENTS

In order to be part of Nicks Kids participants must:

• Maintain a base 2.5 GPA

In order to participate in all trips and events (soccer tournaments) participants must:

- Maintain a GPA above a 2.8
- Captains must maintain a 3.0






OVER THE YEARS
